WEDGE BOUNCE

Wedge bounce is the angle created between the leading edge and the lowest point of the sole or the trailing edge. Bounce can help your club glide through the sand, or keep it from digging into the turf. Bounce provides forgiveness on all wedge shots and allows you to strike the ball properly even if you make mistakes. The best bounce for your wedge depends on your swing type and course conditions. If you are a steeper player that takes big divots, you may want to consider at least one high bounce wedge. If you are a shallow player that takes little to no divot, you may want to consider having at least one low bounce wedge. Firm conditions and less sand in bunkers require low bounce wedges. Medium to soft conditions and fluffy sand require wedges with high bounce. You will see a significant decline in performance on your wedges over time. Replace your wedges every 70 rounds that you play. For the golfer that plays regularly, that comes out to about every 18 to 24 months.

The new Callaway Opus wedges are now available for special order. The new elements of the wedges include more grooves all on the face, offset groove-in-groove for spin when





opening the face, an aggressive face blast which provides spin and bite on partial shots. Opus is available in four different sole shapes from narrow to wide so you can find the right grind for your game. Also, Opus is available in both a brushed chrome and black shadow finish. Tour certified shaping on the wedges include a higher toe peak. Callaway does accept a trade in club from a major manufacturer if you would like to trade in your old wedge and upgrade to an Opus. GOLF TIP: FIXING YOUR HOOK

A hooked shot curves to the left and is caused by a closed club face. check to make your clubface is not shut at address aiming left of the target. Another common cause is a grip which is too strong. The right hand is

too far under the grip which makes the wrists close the clubface. Weaken the grip to show two knuckles at address. Your hands will be turned more toward the target. Another cause of the hook is a stance that is too closed and poor shoulder alignment right of the target.

Get into a square stance and open your shoulders slightly to the left at address. If you are hooking, you will want your ball position to be slightly farther forward in the stance. Feel as if the club is swinging straighter back from the ball instead of to the inside.
