The new Callaway Elyte driver is now available. The Elyte driver's AI 10x face delivers fast ball speeds, outstanding distance,

PLAY READY GOLF

Playing ready golf happens from tee to green and is the

key to speeding up the pace of play. The order of play is based on who is ready at their ball or on the tee box, not who is away. Don't wait for someone who is away but not ready to hit their shot. If you are away but not ready to hit your shot, ask another player to hit. If you are waiting for others to hit, mentally prepare by selecting your club and planning your shot. The twenty-foot putts you have do not need to be read for five minutes. Stand behind the putt, read it for about 10 seconds, then give it your best effort. No honors on the tee box if the person

with the honor is delayed. The first player ready plays. Players should play their own ball before looking for any lost balls. You will make it a great day for everyone when you keep pace with the group in front of you.

HOLE IN ONE

On January 2nd, Kyle Hill aced the 3rd hole with a 50 degree gap wedge from 110 yards.

On January 14th, Jared Melson aced the 3rd hole with a pitching wedge from 155 yards.

GOLF TIP OF THE MONTH: LONG PITCH SHOT

When you are faced with a long pitch shot, there are a few keys to this shot. Experiment with clubs including a gap wedge, pitching wedge, and 9 iron. Determine if you

are going to have the ball back in your stance for more roll, or a more centered ball position for a medium height shot. You can open your stance and club face to add spin. Use light grip pressure and grip down on the club to take some power out of this

shot. Turn your stomach away from the target when taking your backswing. Turn your stomach toward the target, brush the grass, and accelerate down and through the ball. Distance is controlled by the length of the backswing and follow through.
