order. The jailbird head is easy to line up and has a solid but soft feel. The putter is white and navy and has a look that inspires confidence. The head is stable and allows the golfer to smooth their tempo. The putter is forgiving on off center hits. The jailbird mini model comes with versa alignment, a double bend shaft, and is face balanced. The putter comes with an ai-one face insert and stroke lab steel shaft.

#### GOLF TIP OF THE MONTH: PLAYING HOLE #18

Sewailo's 18th hole is a challenging tee shot. The tee shot demands accuracy to avoid the fairway bunkers to the left and the lake all the way up the right side. You have multiple club options for the tee shot. Favor the left side of the fairway with your tee shot. Be careful not to drive the ball too far up the right side, as the fairway slopes toward the lake that runs all the way up to the green. Visualize your line of play from behind the ball. Once you have successfully executed the tee shot, you will be in good position for the second shot. Select the correct club that lands safely onto the green and avoids the green side bunkers. Do not take too much club as any shots flying long will be wet in the lake behind the green.
